HEAD COOK - BARNABAS PREP

We are seeking a Head Cook to work at our sister ministry, Barnabas Prep, in Branson, Missouri.

Barnabas Prep is a two-year faith-based collegiate program designed specifically for young adults with special needs. It is an independent living-learning experience that helps students recognize their strengths and potential, and challenges them to grow into their best selves.

The primary purpose of this position is to oversee the kitchen for Barnabas Prep. The Head Cook should strive to provide quality food while making sure all sanitation procedures are followed. The Head Cook should also ensure that food is plentiful while staying within budget and should maintain open and constant communication with the Food Services Director.

Description of Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide lunch and dinner for all of Prep staff and students, including meals for those with special diets
- Stock supplies for grab and go breakfasts for staff and students
- Supervise Prep staff and students serving on daily meal teams
- Work with Food Services Director to establish menus and recipes
- Ensure that all kitchen staff are following established menus and recipes
- Ensure compliance with health and safety guidelines
- Keep kitchen sanitized and orderly by cleaning/organizing daily
- Deep clean kitchen weekly
- Ensure all food and other items are stored properly
- Place all food orders in accordance with the budget and in a timely manner
- Monitor freshness of food and ingredients
- Maintain inventory of food and supplies
- Ensure that everything is ready for the weekend meals before leaving on Fridays
- Communicate with the Food Services Director regarding any needs or concerns as it pertains to food services.

Requirements:

- Must embrace the mission of Barnabas Foundation
- Ability to work with students who have a wide range of learning, mental, emotional, and physical disabilities
- Basic understanding of food quantities, ordering, & preparation for 100 + people
- Ability to organize and prioritize work
- Work independently with little supervision
- Serve Safe Manager certified or willingness to become certified



Barnabas Prep

This is a part-time position. The Head Cook should work approx. 5-6 hours per day, Monday-Friday, while possibly spending a few extra hours on Friday to do some deep cleaning of the kitchen.

The position includes summers off as well as breaks throughout the year (coincides with the Prep school year which is in session 28 weeks of the year).
